### Animation

- **JTED @ Santa Rita** (Refer to Santa Rita HS bell schedule) + T/TH 4:15-6:45 pm \*M-F 2-4 pm
- Learn skills to create interactive and visually stimulating presentations, 3D modeling, animation, interactive media and digital gaming.
- *Eligibility: Grades 10-12 Credits: 1/year, \*2/year*

### Graphic Design

- Sharpen your artistic skills. Learn to use state-of-the-art software and techniques to design an array of logos, posters, brochures, and more.
- *Eligibility: Grades 10-12 Credits: 1/year*

*Online w/classes twice monthly TBD*
- Learn about design, installation, maintenance and repair of computers, software, and network systems.
- *Eligibility: Grades 11, 12. Credits: 1/year*

## HEALTH SCIENCES



### Healthcare Foundations (HCF)

- **JTED @ Camino Seco**  
*M/W 5-7:30 pm T/TH 2:15-4:45 pm, or 5-7:30 pm*  
**JTED @ Master Pieces** *M/W 2:15-4:45 pm & 5-7:30 pm T/TH 5-7:30 pm*  
**JTED @ Empire** *p-5, p-6*  
*(Refer to Empire bell schedule)*
- This course gives students exposure to a variety of health related and medical careers. It provides fundamentals leading to healthcare careers, including CNA, Medical Assistant, Physical Therapy Aide and EMT.
- *Eligibility: Grades 11, 12. Credits: 1/year*

### Certified Caregiver

- **JTED @ Camino Seco** *M/W 2:15-4:45 pm*  
**JTED @ Master Pieces** *T/TH 2:15-4:45 pm*  
*(Additional weekend hours TBD)*
- Learn to provide support and care for patients incapable of caring for themselves. Become certified to work in private homes and assisted living facilities.
- *Pre-requisite: Healthcare Foundations (HCF)*  
*Eligibility: Grades 11, 12. Credits: 1/year Fees: \$80*



## Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)

- **JTED @ Master Pieces, JTED @ Camino Seco**  
M-TH 1:20-4 pm or 4:20-7 pm (Additional weekend hours TBD)
- Prepare for CNA state licensure by learning to monitor vital signs and help patients with personal needs: bathing, dressing, and eating. Students will complete 185 hours of classroom instruction, skills lab and gain real world experience working in long-term care facilities.
- *Pre-requisite: Healthcare Foundations (HCF)*  
*Credits: 3/year Fees: \$80*

## Certified Nursing Assistant + Caregiver 1-Year Program

- *HCF/CNA/Caregiver 1-year course for GED earners, HS Grads, students with alternate schedules (must be under age 21).*
- **JTED @ Camino Seco, JTED @ Master Pieces**  
M-TH 7:30 am - 12:30 pm  
(Additional weekend hours TBD)  
*Credits: 4/year Fees: \$80*

## Medical Assistant

- **JTED @ Master Pieces, JTED @ Empire** M-TH  
2:45-6:45 pm (Additional weekend hours TBD)
- Master skills needed to work with patients in a clinic or physician's office. Learn how to collect blood and other specimen samples, set up surgical trays, perform screenings for diseases, and collect patients' vitals, and medical history.
- *Pre-requisite: Healthcare Foundations (HCF)*  
*Credits: 4/year Fees: \$80*

## Physical Therapy Aide **\*NEW\***

- **JTED @ Master Pieces** M-TH 2:45-6:45 pm
- Learn about injury recognition and physical therapy techniques to assist with patient rehabilitation.
- *Pre-requisite: Healthcare Foundations (HCF)*  
*Credits: 3/year Fees: \$80*

## HOSPITALITY EDUCATION & HUMAN SERVICES



### Cosmetology

- **JTED @ Master Pieces, JTED @ Camino Seco**
- Prepare to earn your Arizona State Board of Cosmetology license through both theory and hands-on experience. Master hair cutting, styling and color, skin care, nail technology, infection control and salon management while completing 1600 program hours.
- *Pre-requisite: Minimum 10 HS credits, including 2 in English by program start (must provide transcripts), or GED or HS Diploma (must be under age 21)*
- *Credits: 12.5 upon program completion. Fees: \$210/year*
- *2-Year program: M-F 4-7:30 pm. \*There is summer school between the first and second year. Dates and times TBD*
- *1-Year program: 8 am - 2:30 pm, 1-7:30 pm. This 1-year program begins in June 2015. Dates and times TBD*





## Culinary Arts

- **JTED @ Mountain View** (Refer to Mt. View HS bell schedule) + T/TH 4-6:30 pm  
**JTED @ Santa Rita** (Refer to Santa Rita HS bell schedule) + T/TH 4:15-6:45 pm, \*M-F 2-4 pm
- Gain experience in a commercial kitchen using state-of-the-art equipment and professional culinary tools. Advanced students train on-the-job through JTED's catering services.
- *Eligibility: Grades 10-12. Credits: 1/year; \*2/year*

## Early Childhood Education

- **JTED @ Mountain View** (Refer to Mt. View HS bell schedule) + T/TH 4-6:30 pm
- Learn about child development and acquire skills needed to work with and care for infant-to-school-age children. Advanced students gain hands-on experience in the Little Lions preschool.
- *Eligibility: Grades 10-12. Credits: 1/year*
- *Additional requirements: Proof of Mantoux TB skin test, Tetanus shot w, Pertussis by start*

## INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGIES

### Industrial Technology Foundations (ITF) \*NEW\*

- **JTED @ Master Pieces** T/TH 4-6:30 pm  
**JTED @ Walden Grove** M/W 4-6:30 pm
- This pre-requisite course is an overview and preparation for careers and fields related to industrial technologies--Electrical Power & Transmission, Heavy Equipment Operation, and Diesel Maintenance and Repair.
- *Eligibility: Grades 11, 12. Credits: 1/year*

## Automotive Technologies

- **JTED @ Baboquivari** (Refer to Baboquivari HS bell schedule)
- Use our CDX automotive training system. Learn general engine performance diagnosis and repair, and how to evaluate and fix brakes, steering, suspension, electrical, and electronic systems.
- *Eligibility: Grades 9-12. Credits: 1/year*

## Aviation Technology

- **JTED @ Pima Community College Aviation Center** M-TH 4-6:30 pm
- The Aviation Program teaches total aircraft maintenance: from wheels, brakes, and hydraulics, to engines, controls, and electrical systems. The course curriculum prepares students for certification testing as airframe and powerplant technicians.
- *Eligibility: Grades 11,12 Minimum 12 HS credits Credits: 2/year Additional requirements: Transcript, PCC A# & PCC Assessment Scores*

## Diesel Mechanics \*NEW\*

- **JTED @ Sahuarita** M-TH 3:30-7:30 pm
- Learn to repair and overhaul heavy diesel equipment using advanced computer diagnostic systems--troubleshoot and maintain diesel engines, electrical, hydraulic, pneumatic and refrigeration systems.
- *Pre-requisite: Industrial Technologies Foundations or NCCER Certification Eligibility: Grade 12. Credits: 3/year*





## Electrical Power Transmission **\*NEW\***

- **JTED @ Tucson Electric Power** M-TH 4-6:30 pm
- Prepare to earn your Certificate for Direct Employment and become eligible for TEP's Pre-Apprenticeship Program. Learn about installation, repair and maintenance of electrical and telecommunications infrastructure and systems.
- *Pre-requisite: Industrial Technology Foundations or NCCER Certification*  
*Eligibility: Grade 12. Credits: 2/year*

## Heavy Equipment Operations **\*NEW\***

- **JTED @ Walden Grove** T/TH 3:30-7:30 pm
- Learn about surveying, excavation, and operation of heavy equipment like bulldozers, scrapers, motor graders and other construction and site preparation equipment.
- *Pre-requisite: Industrial Technology Foundations or NCCER Certification*  
*Eligibility: Grade 12. Credits: 3/year*

## Precision Manufacturing

- **JTED @ Tanque Verde** (Refer to Tanque Verde HS bell schedule)
- Learn precision engineering and manufacturing with an emphasis on the design and performance of machining tools, metrology, tooling elements, machine structures, sources of errors, precision machining processes and process planning.
- *Eligibility: Grades 10-12. Credits: 1/year*

## PUBLIC SERVICE



### Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

- **JTED @ Empire** T/TH 3:30-7:30 pm  
**JTED @ Master Pieces** M/W 3:30-7:30 pm  
(Additional Saturday classes TBD)
- Learn about Emergency Medical Systems and prepare for licensure as an Emergency Medical Technician. Gain skills in patient assessment, basic triage, and scene safety.
- *Pre-requisite: Healthcare Foundations (HCF) or approved pre-requisite. Contact a JTED counselor for pre-requisite approval.*  
*Eligibility: Grade 12. Credits: 3/year*

### Fire Service

- **JTED @ Camino Seco** M/W 3:30-7:30 pm  
**JTED @ Master Pieces** T/TH 3:30-7:30 pm  
(Additional Saturday classes TBD)
- Participate in classroom activities, physical training, and hands-on applications with a team of professional firefighters. Learn fire service safety policies and procedures, earn CPR/First Aid, Hazmat and Wildlands certifications.
- *Eligibility: Grade 11, 12. Credits: 3/year*
- *Additional requirements: Participation Physical, current for the 2015-16 school year.*

- *Eligibility: Grades 11, 12. Credits: 3/year*  
*Additional requirements: Participation Physical, current for the 2015-16 school year.*

- **JTED @ UAMC South, JTED @ UA Main Campus** M-F 8 am -3 pm
- Project SEARCH serves students with significant intellectual and developmental disabilities who are in their last year of high school.

*Credits: 2/year*

### Agriscience

- **JTED @ Tanque Verde** (Refer to Tanque Verde HS bell schedule)
- Learn about care and management of large and small animals, wildlife research, animal health, anatomy, and physiology.
- *Eligibility: Grades 10-12. Credits: 1/year*

### Veterinary Science

- **JTED @ Amphi Land Lab** M/W 4-6:30 pm  
**JTED @ Tanque Verde** (Refer to Tanque Verde HS bell schedule) + T/TH 4-6:30 pm
- Explore the science of veterinary medicine. Learn about treatment and care for large and small animals as part of a veterinary team in a clinic, lab, and farm setting.
- *Eligibility: Grades 11, 12. Credits: 1/year*

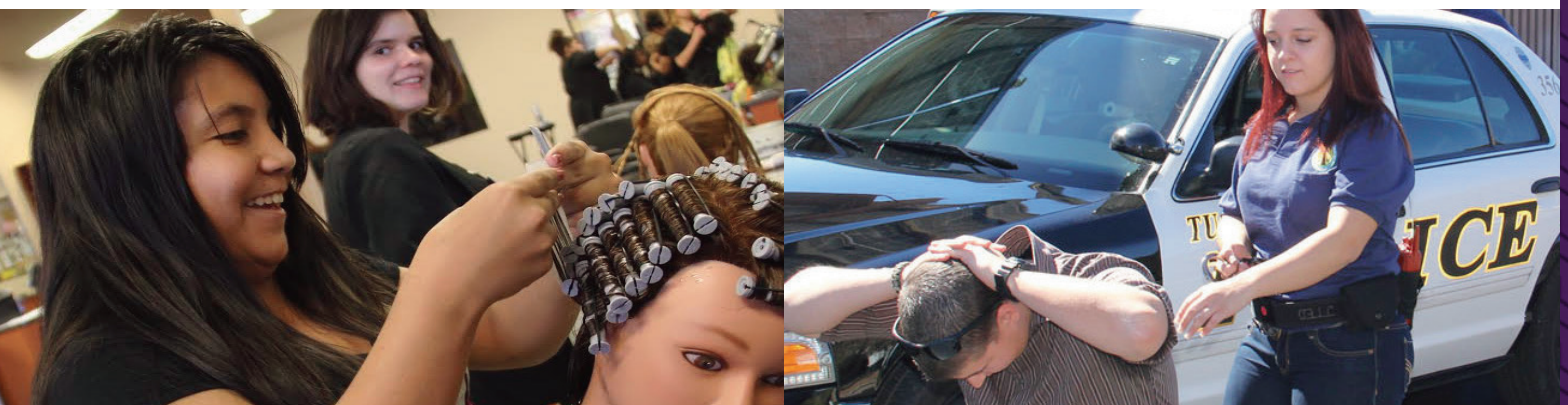
